Where a matter cannot be completed e.g. because of lack of documents, we will charge you for any work we have done at our hourly rate of £250 per hour, plus VAT.

A discount of £55 applies to some of the above categories for nationals of Turkey or Macedonia.

All fees are exclusive of VAT which is applied at the current rate of 20%.

Disbursements

All disbursements will need to be paid for separately in addition to the fees for our services. Examples of disbursements include Home Office application fees, court fees, recorded and special delivery, courier fees, interpreting and translation services, medical reports fees, expert report fees, mileage/travel expenses etc. This is not an exhaustive list and is meant purely as a guide.

Costs on Account

We require an initial payment of at least half of the fee at the start of your matter and the remainder before your application is submitted. All disbursements must be paid before they are incurred by us.

Processing times

Whilst we will endeavour to deal with your matters as promptly as possible and provide you with updates, we are unable to influence Home Office decision making times and therefore cannot guarantee how long it will take for them to process your application.
